


Statement of California Proposition 65 Compliance (Updated 2025)

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) requires businesses to provide warnings if their products can expose individuals to chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. The Proposition 65 chemical list is updated at least annually and now includes 1,000+ substances.

Electri-Cord Manufacturing Company (ECM) reviews materials used in its products against the current Proposition 65 list. Certain chemicals may be present in our products, including (but not limited to) lead, nickel, DINP, DEHP, DBP, and BBP. These substances are also regulated under RoHS and REACH; where present, they are within those regulatory limits. However, because Proposition 65 is based on exposure risk rather than ppm content, even low levels may require a warning under California law.

Customer Guidance

- Our products are intended for industrial and commercial use and are not sold directly to consumers.
- When required, Proposition 65 warnings are provided on packaging, product labeling, or accompanying documentation in the following format:

 **CA WARNING:** This product can expose you to chemicals including Diisononyl Phthalate (DINP), Lead, and Antimony Trioxide, which are known to the State of California to cause cancer and/or reproductive harm. For more information, visit www.P65Warnings.ca.gov.

All suppliers to ECM must notify us promptly of any changes in material formulations that could introduce or increase levels of Proposition 65 substances.
